The club milling team will be sawing Silky Oak and Camphor Laurel logs into slabs using the Lucas Mill. The slabs once seasoned and dressed make beautiful table tops, or the slabs can be cut into lumber to make cabinets and boxes. The slabs, "green off saw" will be available for purchase. Logs are collected by the team from around Cooroy and include many hard to find species such as Hoop Pine, Avacado, Jacaranda and Red Cedar. Some seasoned and surfaced pieces will also be on sale.
