The inaugural meeting of the Cooroora Woodworkers Club was held at the Tewantin Scout Den on 14/12/1988. Founding and first Club President, Ron Salmon, placed an advertisement in a local newspaper and attracted about fourteen interested "woodies", of which there are still four foundation members. The Club became incorporated on the 8<sup>th</sup> of October 1989.

Membership at present averages around 110, consisting of Woodturners, Woodcarvers, Toymakers, Scrollsawers, Cabinetmakers, Box makers, Pyrographers, and those who like to try their hand at many different skills.

A craft demonstration, show, and sale festival has been held since 1989 and we now hold one major Show a year in September at the Cooroy Memorial Hall, in which many local groups and individuals with varying skills and talents participate. These have now become a permanent fixture in the Club's calendar of activities. The Shows have been very well supported by generous sponsorship from the Noosa Shire Council and Cooroy businesses, and are also very well supported by the community, which looks forward to the annual event.

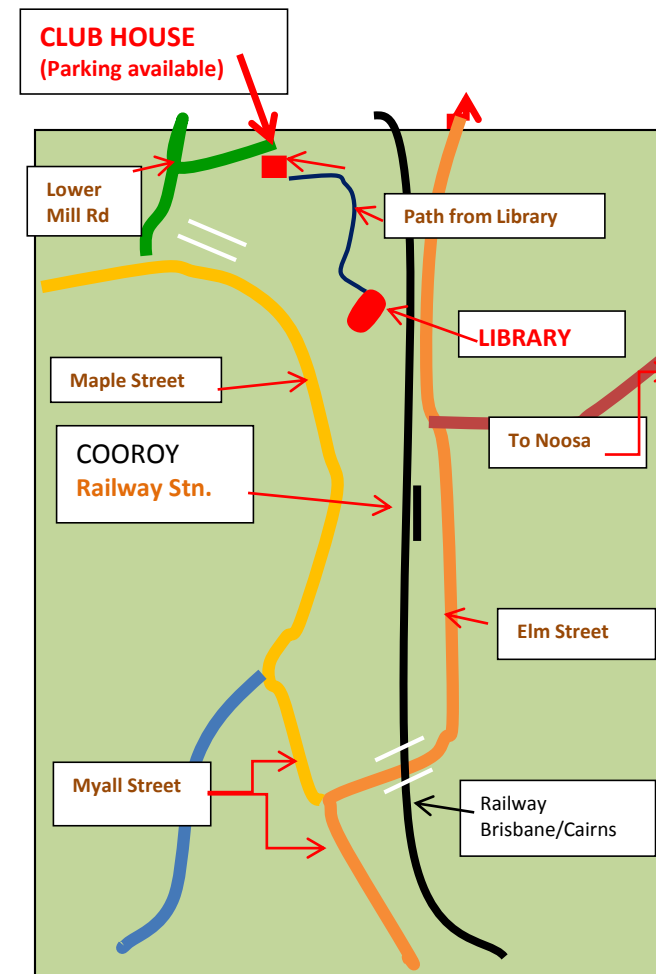
